



Conflict Minerals Policy Statement

Current Chemicals is dedicated to respect for human rights, integrity, and environmental responsibility. We are committed to responsible sourcing and to ensuring that our products do not directly or indirectly contribute to armed conflict or serious human rights abuses.

Current Chemicals is committed to ensuring that we are not sourcing tin, tantalum, tungsten, gold ("3TG") that fund armed groups in the Democratic Republic of Congo (DRC) and adjoining countries, in accordance with the Organization for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD) Due Diligence Guidance for Responsible Supply Chain of Minerals from Conflict-Affected and High-Risk Areas.

We expect our suppliers to have a Conflict Minerals Policy in place. In the case where any 3TG are intentionally added and are necessary to the functionality or production of any applicable product, our suppliers must complete the Conflict Minerals Reporting Template (CMRT) as published by the Responsible Minerals Initiative (RMI).

When potential risk is identified in our supply chain, CCI engages suppliers to clarify, remediate, or adjust sourcing as needed. If a supplier is unable or unwilling to meet our expectations or to address identified risks within agreed timeframes, CCI may suspend or terminate the business relationship.

Through these measures, Current Chemicals seeks to maintain a conflict free supply chain, uphold human rights, and meet the responsible sourcing expectations of our customers and stakeholders.
